Founded in 1849 by James and John Forsythe, Thorndale was named for the thorny landscape that once characterized the area. The village developed as an industrial hub in Cala Township, home to the Thorndale Iron Works, a post office established in 1854, and a railroad station added in 1875. Thorndale is also historically notable for "Ingleside," the summer home of James Buchanan. Today, the area has evolved into an active commercial corridor, and projects like this lighting improvement help support its continued growth while improving safety and accessibility.

For this project in Thorndale, Independence Lighting worked with Spring City Electrical to supply new light poles and fixtures for the Route 30 corridor, helping enhance visibility, safety, and the overall streetscape. Independence Lighting also assisted with fixture selection and lighting design support, contributing to a safer and more welcoming environment for residents, businesses, and visitors. The upgraded lighting reflects an ongoing investment in infrastructure that strengthens the community and supports future growth.
