The historic State Street Bridge, also known as the Soldiers and Sailors Memorial Bridge, has served as a prominent gateway into downtown Harrisburg since its completion in 1930. Built as a tribute to American service members following World War I, the bridge features monumental pylons topped with eagles representing the U.S. Army and Navy and was later listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

With the help of Independence Lighting and Spring City Electrical, new custom poles were supplied along the bridge, enhancing visibility for motorists and pedestrians while highlighting its distinctive architectural features. The updated illumination helps preserve the character of this historic landmark while creating a safer and more welcoming entrance to Pennsylvania's capital city.
