


Reading Pagoda Remastered (2025)

Perched atop Mount Penn, the Reading Pagoda is one of the city's most iconic and historic landmarks. Constructed in 1908 as part of a luxury resort, the Pagoda has evolved into a cherished symbol of the city, known for its distinctive architecture and panoramic views.

This project marked Independence Lighting's second time illuminating this historic structure, reinforcing a continued commitment to preserving and enhancing its visual presence.

Independence Lighting delivered integrated lighting and controls solutions supporting both interior and exterior scopes. Services included supplying lighting fixtures, assisting with interior low-voltage control wiring schematics, and producing one-line diagrams for exterior lighting controls. The team assisted with network control rack design and performed programming, addressing, and commissioning of exterior lighting systems, along with commissioning of interior lighting controls.

Detailed lighting takeoffs ensured procurement accuracy, while ongoing project oversight supported coordination, quality execution, and successful completion.
